<u>Introduction</u>

Abbotts Ball Farm Cottage is situated on the southern edge of the village of Potterne, two miles from the market town of Devizes, and commands outstanding views across the surrounding countryside towards Salisbury Plain. Its central position in Wiltshire makes it an ideal centre for touring and, with many peaceful local bridleways and byways; it makes an ideal area for walking. Within a couple of miles, access can be gained to Salisbury Plain.

The spacious cottage sleeps up to five people and is tastefully and comfortably furnished to a high standard, making it a real "home from home".

Abbotts Ball Farm is a working smallholding with a horse livery yard. The Cottage overlooks a large flower- bordered lawn, whilst at the rear there is a gentle slope leading to a half acre lawn with several benches and seats, giving our guests magnificent views across the beautiful Wiltshire countryside, and where children are welcome to play ball games safely. There is a patio area which can be accessed from the lounge front door by one shallow step, which has a wooden table and chairs with a parasol, and barbeque available for our guests.

Locally, there are excellent golf courses and fishing availability, a leisure centre in Devizes with heated swimming pool and a variety of indoor and outdoor sports. Canal boat hire is also available from Devizes on the Kennet & Avon Canal.

Pre-arrival

Rural buses between Trowbridge and Devizes pass the gate. It is a "request stop" service. Buses to Bath and Salisbury depart from the Village Post Office approximately half a mile away. Time tables are available.

The C246 Worton Road outside the Cottage has no footpath to the village until approximately the last 100 yards where there is a narrow, fairly steep pathway to the main A360.

There are several local companies that supply equipment for hire; details available on request.

The nearest Shopmobility is in Swindon, approximately 20 miles away.

Shopping can be ordered and delivered to the Cottage in time for your arrival via local supermarkets, Tesco, Sainsbury and Iceland.

Key collection, Welcome and Car Parking

The Cottage is attached to the owner's property and Hazel or John will meet you on arrival to give you the key and to show you around the Cottage and familiarise you.

Parking for two cars is available on a gravelled area approximately 20 yards from either front or rear Cottage entrance doors.

The parking area leads to three steps to the paved front pathway (although these steps can be avoided by using a lawn area to the side of the steps). Alternatively the parking area leads to a slightly sloping path to the back door of the Cottage.

The area is lit by motion sensor lights.

Entrance to Property

There is one shallow step from paved pathway to the front door, which leads into the lounge/diner. Alternatively a step-free access entrance is available to the rear door.

Entrance is well lit.

Carpet to floor in lounge.

Front door is 32.5"/800mm wide.

Lounge/Diner

Situated on the ground floor, with a shallow step from front pathway into lounge, and with level access to or from the kitchen.

The room has a mixture of seating with a sofa, easy chairs and a higher chair with arms.

Nest of coffee tables and a single low table with table lamp.

Digital television DVD/video player with remote control and.

Dining area has a table (height 30"/760mm) and dining chairs without arms.

Sideboard holding extra cutlery, table mats, table cloths, glasses, bowls, books and games.

Oak cupboard with cleaning equipment and iron, together with games, under the stairs. Plus ironing board under stairs.
